There's More to the ASIS Secondary Programme

The SIS Group of Schools

The history of the SIS group of schools traces back to 1996 and is deeply rooted in the mission of its founder Jaspal Sidhu, which is to bring quality and affordable education to different income levels through world-class schools established in major cities around the world.

It was no surprise that the Founder turned to his home country, Singapore, renowned for its education system, for inspiration. To ensure a solid foundation to the start of the first SIS campus, the cooperation of the Founder's alma mater, Raffles Institution (Singapore's premier school) was secured.

Further encouraged by members of the Singapore Government, and senior members of the Ministry of Education back then, the first Singapore International School of the SIS Group was established in Indonesia, the fourth most populous country in the world.

The success of all SIS Schools comes from its focus on the 3Ps of a good school: People, Programme and Place. Great teachers and non-teaching staff ensure that our people create outstanding teaching and learning environments everywhere. The SIS programme focuses on the unpredictable future of our learners, honing of life skills and dispositions will remain central to our pedagogy. Holistic Assessments

Each child comes with their own personality and learning curve. ASIS subscribes to the holistic assessment of each child thus nurturing the desire to learn and grow as a learner. Continuous monitoring, informal interactions, parental feedback, along with formal assessments such as score-tracking, semestral examinations and international benchmarking are used.

Academic Support Programme

For learners who are still developing towards the expectations of a subject area, ASIS has an Academic Support Programme, where teachers will give individual support and attention to the learner, outside curriculum time. Along with the differentiation within classes, this allows them personalized attention and the ability to progress towards goals in an encouraging, non-pressurized environment.

The PACE Initiative

The ASIS programme revolves around developing the whole child for life, work and school through our PACE initiative:

Perseverance: We help our learners to understand adversity and to persevere. We guide and coach them closely in their journey towards their own goals.

Analytical Thinking: ASIS Learners are taught to analyse before solving problems. They test predictions and generate solutions. They learn to plan, prioritize and take action.

Communication and Collaboration: These, along with trust, are explicitly maintained at high levels throughout our community. Learners are given opportunities to learn in teams. They explicitly learn how to communicate and collaborate effectively.

Entrepreneurism: Our learners will be encouraged, guided, coached to develop an entrepreneurial spirit along with the skills and dispositions needed to identify, create and make the best of opportunity around them.

The ASIS Programme

- Encourages a strong grounding in STEM subjects (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics)
- Ensures a sound foundation in languages (English, Tamil, mother tongue and others), Humanities, Physical Education and the Creative Arts
- Explicitly enhances their personal and interpersonal development throughout the curriculum and co-curricular opportunities by involving learners in decision-making
- Exposes learners to relationships between communities and the physical environment to nurture good global and local citizens
- Introduces our learners to the fundamentals of the business world and requires them to undertake a number of inter-disciplinary projects that will hone their research, writing, analytical and presentation skills

The Lower Secondary Program

- Runs the Cambridge Checkpoint curriculum
- Exposes learners to a wide range of learning opportunities
- Helps learners choose and prepare for IGCSEs in upper primary

The Upper Secondary Program

- Learners develop and prove themselves through the University of Cambridge International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) as the international benchmark
- This allows them to test out their learner attributes in several academic areas and prepares them for the IB Diploma in their High school/Junior College days
